UPDATE - OCTOBER 2014

The Maccabi Victoria All Abilities program continues to show remarkable growth and development. Below is a summary of some of our key successes over the last few months



All Abilities Events and Opportunities:

- Leadership programs including assistant at soccer games, volunteers at all abilities events and youth leaders in the junior carnival.
- Work experience as a table tennis coach and as a sports teacher assistant at the King David School.
- Partnership events with mainstream clubs to offer 'come and try days' such as the soccer, cricket, table tennis, lawn bowls and swimming clubs
- Collaboration with other organisations such as Jewish Care in various events including inaugural weekly table tennis and walking groups
- Expanding the variety of programs for all abilities by offering recreational events within the sporting arena such as attending an AFL match with the AJAX FC.
- Supporting and celebrating inclusive elite competitions such as Zvi Schweitzer in Tennis Australia Championships as well as Mattie Michaels and Guy Slome in the 'Round the Bay' cycle fundraiser event.
- Inviting members to be key advocates for our initiative by having representation on our committee and appointing community ambassador positions.

- Growth in various regular sporting activities such as basketball, soccer, walking and table tennis.
- Integration of our members and programs into mainstream clubs such as basketball, swimming, tennis and tenpin bowling.

Administration:

- Over 50 all abilities members now registered with Maccabi Victoria.
- A 66% growth to our database over the last 3 months, with another 20% anticipated over the next 3 months.
- Rollout of indiviudalised plan approaches including face-to-face meetings with all new members and personalising service operations.
- Developments of draft 2014-2016 strategic plan and budget.
- Expanding volunteer networks, currently including 50 key contacts, by working closely with clubs and schools for recruitment.
- Attending professional development and networking opportunities including trainings on CPR first aid, disability awareness, NDIS and supporting volunteers with a disability.



Policy and procedure:

Supporting the roll out of the Maccabi Australia's
 Member Protection Policy, including a chapter on disability inclusion and awareness. The MAI MPP will be rolled out over the next few months.

Stakeholder relationship development:

- Strengthening working relationship with disability service providers including Jewish Care, Access Inc. The Friendship Circle, Scope Vic and Camp Sababa through collaborative events and committees e.g. Maccabi President joining the new 'Social Inclusion Leadership Committee'.
- Linking in with key inclusive sport and recreational services for including Reclink, Basketball Victoria, FIDA, Netball Victoria and Sport & Rec Vic.
- Seeking support from Jewish School integration programs and local special need schools.
- Presenting at Access Inc. and Jewish Spectrum support groups.
- Working with Melbourne Universities and SEDA to provide student placement opportunities.
- Capacity building of key Maccabi Victoria clubs by hosting our first Disability Awareness Training.
- · Hosting parent/carer feedback sessions.



Marketing and promotion:

- Editing and distribution of monthly newsletter to key stakeholders.
- Regular updates to Facebook pages, with currently over 120 followers.
- Frequent additions to the All Abilities website,
 smartphone app, all abilities community calendar and Mac-Chat.
- Promotion via flyers and brochures in schools, shules and other disability services (such as 'Time for a Break' manual).
- Continued visibility in the mainstream media such as the Australian Jewish News.



Grants, funding and sponsorship:

- Successful grants for over \$2000 from Stonington
 City Council and Sport & Rec Vic.
- Sourcing alternative income streams via sponsorship, grants, philanthropic funding and subsidised player registration fees.
