The carnival was an incredible success and was an inspiring example of true integration and inclusion. We were thrilled to be able to provide 28 of our All Abilities members and volunteers with the opportunity to get involved as:

- Volunteers by working behind the scenes at various sporting and social events including as pre-carnival preparation assistants, catering assistants, ushering, bump-in support, running ticket sales and collection.
- Youth Leaders, who volunteered alongside the other mainstream youth leaders before and during the carnival to support the participants to stay safe and have fun.
- Participant, Charley Fox, joined in all of the sporting and social activities with the mainstream participants with additional support from youth leaders.

All Abilities Events and Opportunities:

 Offering eight regular active sporting opportunities offered for All Abilities members (basketball, Israeli dancing, lawn bowls, soccer, swimming, table tennis, tennis, walking group)

- Volunteer roles created and running in Maccabi
 Victoria offices as administration assistant, at various
 functions and events including as soccer games
 assistant and 13 members volunteering at the In One
 Voice Festival.
- Programs for children with disabilities including inaugural multi-sports clinic and integration into mainstream teams.
- Paid work for members as coaches and sports teacher assistants at King David.

Administration:

- Succession planning for Lauren Mandel, current All Abilities Inclusion Coordinator including development of handover and training manuals and promotion of job availability.
- Jewish Disability Services Guide developed with submissions from other organisations, to be launched and distributed in April 2015.
- Online registration forms and accompanying userguide compiled and distributed to members.
- Overview of Maccabi Victoria All Abilities programs document composed and projected calendar of events for 2015 being developed.
- 4-month student internship completed by Exercise and Health Science graduate, Georgia Dyer.

- Meeting with special need schools via joint community visits program with Access Inc. and Jewish Care.
- Connecting with carers and families of people with disabilities via attendance carer's support groups.
- Linking with interstate bodies Maccabi NSW and Maccabi Junior Carnival NSW, offering practical advice/support for inclusive program development
- Continued strong collaboration with other disability service via collaborative events, committees, shared resources
- Working with Melbourne Universities and SEDA to provide student placement and internship opportunities.
- Continued capacity building for Maccabi Victoria clubs through provision of resources and support.
- Liaising with King David School to support all abilities member receive paid work as a sports teacher assistant.
